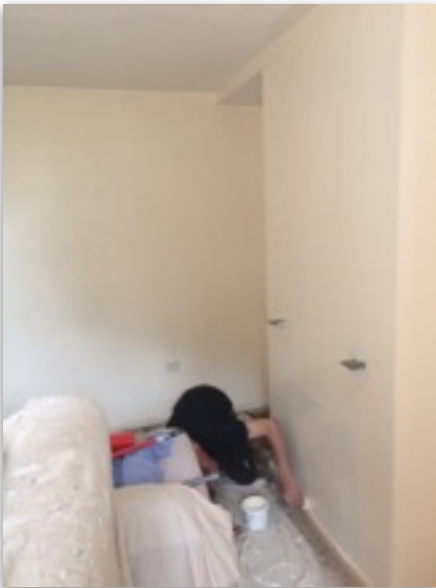
PROJECT No. 278 DECORATING IN TAUNTON

The recipient had done a lot of good preparation work to the lounge walls, ready for us to get straight to work. He was also very keen to help with the decorating himself. It was not a big room so the four of us were just about the right amount. We all did the initial cleaning down of the ceiling, walls and woodwork and then set about with the rollers and brushes.



As usual, it didn't take long to colour the ceiling and walls and these were done by lunchtime. After lunch we were straight on with painting the woodwork.

The recipient was hands on all the way through the works and was so pleased to see the transformation of the room, which had been needing this redecoration for several months.
