PROJECT No. 285 DECORATING IN TAUNTON



This decorating project followed a referral from Adult Social Care. The recipient had become wheelchair-bound following a major health issue and lengthy rehabilitation, which was ongoing. Work had been carried out to adapt her home and make it accessible for the wheelchair, however some decorating was needed in the kitchen and lounge to complete it.



A team of five timegivers from St James and Vineyard churches came together on the day to take on the project. Two were set to work painting the walls and woodwork in the lounge, which was quite small but challenging, as they had to work around the furniture. The remaining team members worked in the kitchen, transforming the long dark purple wall into a lighter pale grey. A fresh coat of paint on a short wall, doorway and woodwork in the kitchen finished the project.

The recipient was very happy with the result and the team, from different churches, enjoyed getting to know each other and working together.

Prayers were said for the recipient's continued recovery and rehabilitation.
