sweep away suffering

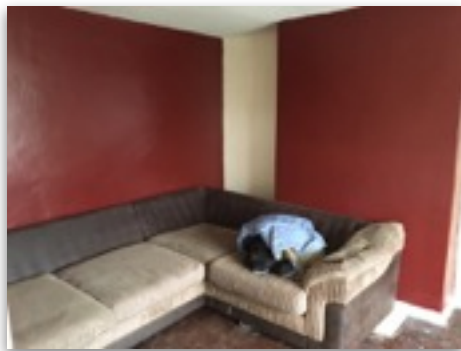
## PROJECT No. 286 DECORATING IN TAUNTON
